Travel End of Season Report

## BU12

GU10

• Having two balanced teams is not working well because better players on these teams are not being served well. Challenger coaches believe that there should be only skill based teams

### GU&BU12

- A teams are likely candidates for MTOC tournament in Spring.
- Coaches must communicate with parents before start of season that playoffs will likely happen after the end of the season and to try to keep their schedules available, if possible

In-Town end of season report

- No players are identified as being candidates to move up to U10
- Idea is being suggested to hold separate U7 & U8. Discussion was tabled until next meeting because there were no In Town Coordinators present

NVYSL update

- Issue about player pass cards was raised at NVYSL meeting. Apparently coaches were not aware of this. No further action.
- NVYSL meeting is next week on 11/10. Rika is looking for someone to attend with her.

### Challenger report

- Tom & Niamh are preparing an end of season summary for us to review, discuss and possibly implement in the off season
- Tom thought this was one of the best seasons of soccer he has seen
- He thinks we should start teaching players a position at U12
- With U6, he thinks the format oould be improved. One idea is to have a practice in addition to the game as a way of developing a sense of team.
- Niamh is not sure if she will return in the Spring. Feedback from parents and coaches was positive
- Tom is trying to decide whether or not to return. He is evaluating coaching opportunities with Challenger in other states.

#### Player Development

- U10 & U12 clinics were well received but sparsely attended. Steve feels as if the program is slowly growing but will continue to grow.
- Joint practices with U10 and U12 A & B teams worked well. Sessions were well attended. Challenger coaches felt that theses particularly helped the B players because they were forced to play up to the A players level
- Request for more Goalkeeper training because players are afraid to play the position
