- Minutes from January meeting were approved by unanimous board vote

- The following Action Items came out of the discussion

- Allyson: verify placement of the new player in BU12.
- All: check minutes to determine if Board ratified keeper policy. Initial findings indicated that it did not.
- Steve S: confirm whether Alex at Challenger is coming back
- Allyson: alert coordinators to distribute rosters in advance one week (February 23)
- Allyson: will come up with proposed timeframe for when we need field clarity
- · Unassigned: fields need fertilizer-follow up with parks and rec

General Meeting Minutes

- There was a discussion of the goalkeeper for U18
 - The board discussed the balance between having one primary goalkeeper vs balanced play for the 3 keepers on the team
 - The board agreed that this should be approached within the current framework of the club handbook

- BU16/18 update

- · 36 kids total
- · After a lot of work, there are enough kids for a U16 team this year
- 13 Juniors and Seniors, balance sophomores
- 5 kids need to be moved up to U18
- 6 U16 teams in league overall
- · No more registrations will be accepted for these age groups
- The club will hold tryouts for final 5 U18 slots
- The board will provide assistance on tryouts

- · The last person registered will not get a slot on a team
- Coaching Peter W, Dan D, Malcolm Carley for U16
- U18 is looking for coaches. Contact Karl with ideas.

- GU14

- GU18

- 17 players today, no keeper yet.
- The club is following up on potential interest from a keeper in Clinton

- BU14

- 30 kids
- · Will hold tryouts to divide them

- BU12

- Requested moving A team to MTOC2
- Open position on goalie slot. Evaluating new player as an option.
- Currently 11/14/13 kids from A/B/C
- · Discussion of whether to move a keeper up from B team
- Registration will remain open.
- BU10
 - Roughly the same numbers as last season-- registration down by 2 overall
 - A few kids not coming back, some new kids
- GU10
 - No update
- ⁻ In-town U6/7/8
 - Numbers tracking okay, on pace for same area as fall 2013, roughly 150-160 overall
- GU12
 - · Considering some movement across A and B teams
 - The challenge of balancing team size and trying to avoid moving a player down was discussed
 - · Current thinking is to keep this as-is
- Challenger update
 - Spring contract has been received

- No rate increase rates this year
- · Coaches Tom is coming back, Nieve is likely coming back

- Steve Stecyk attended recent soccer conference, focused the visit on Rec team development
- Conference Takeaways
 - Club doing a lot right
 - Joint practices
 - Suggested emphasis on "Kicking is Not Soccer" approach, a draft of which was

distributed. This emphasizes the importance of dribbling skills development. We'll introduce this at the coaches meeting, scheduled in March

- Will change tone of upcoming coaches meeting since all coaches are coming back
- F course was provided in January. It went well-- 5 Harvard coaches attended. 20 total. Feedback was great.
- Fitchburg offering one in March, one day
- March 8 is deadline for rosters being finalized (all items finalized on website).

- The board discussed the recommendation to have kids bring their own balls.

- The board discussed whether fees should be raised more in alignment with NVYSL costs which are currently very disproportionate, e.g. U18 ~\$600, U10 ~ \$125
- · The board will discuss this further in upcoming meetings

- League meeting update

- · Changes in U10 on goalkeeping goalkeepers can punt past halfway
- Proposed bylaw change paid coaches can be 4th non-rostered coach on the sidelines
- · League voted to cover costs of Bromfield for coaching clinic
